Dear Parents, Carers and Families

This week our Year 3 and 5 students will participate in NAPLAN. Children across Australia in Years 3, 5, 7, & 9 will be tested on Reading, Writing, Language conventions, and Numeracy. The testing is a snapshot of where the children are at with their learning and maps their achievement against the national average. Parents will receive a copy of the achievement report during Term 3. Ludmilla Primary approaches all learning and assessment with a 'can do' attitude and encourages all children to do their best at all times. Parents and families can support their child by making sure they get to bed on time and keeping a regular routine. The best sort of encouragement a parent can give is to tell their child, "try your best and don't give up". Ludmilla Primary will be providing a cooked breakfast each morning to ensure that all children are well fed and hydrated ready to focus and concentrate on each assessment.

VAMP Television provides programs for schools that highlight learning through the 'Arts'. They are visiting our Ludmilla Early Education Precinct this week to film one of our Playgroup music sessions. This is an exciting opportunity for our school to highlight our Families as First Teachers Playgroups and the way our families and their children are learning together through music and song.

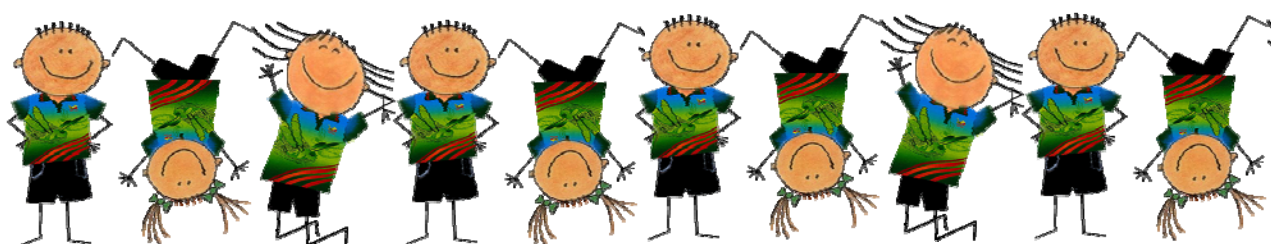
